

NSBA COVID-19 PROTOCOL - OUTBREAK PLAN

Early detection of COVID-19 symptoms will facilitate the immediate implementation of effective control measures. In addition, the early detection and immediate implementation of enhanced cleaning measures are two (2) of the most important factors in limiting the size and length of an outbreak. An "outbreak" is two or more cases; a "case" is a single case of COVID-19.

- 1. If and when a COVID-19 outbreak is reported in relation to a NSBA baseball event, team, or volunteer, any person knowledgeable of the outbreak will notify NSBA President at president@northshorebaseball.ca. In such a case, the NSBA Executive has authority to modify, restrict, postpone or cancel activities in consultation with public health agencies.
- 2. If an NSBA player or member of a player's household is confirmed of having COVID-19, they are strongly encouraged to contact their team coach who will contact NSBA Safety Officer at safetyofficer@northshorebaseball.ca who will inform the NSBA Executive. NSBA will notify the field permit provider and take necessary including possible enhanced cleaning measures to reduce risk of transmission.
- 3. If NSBA suspects a case or confirms a case or outbreak of influenza-like-illness, NSBA will immediately report and discuss the suspected outbreak with the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority's Medical Health Officer (or delegate). NSBA will fully cooperate with the Medical Health Officer directions.
