BC Minor Baseball Association Scholarship Information

BC Minor Baseball Association (BCMBA) is dedicated to assisting worthy applicants in their desire to attend post-secondary education. BCMBA may grant, at most, four \$500 scholarships per year to four successful applicants who have demonstrated proficiency in baseball or umpiring for three or more years within a BCMBA association. The applicants must have played or umpired within an association that is a member in good standing with the BC Minor Baseball Association. *Please note: BCMBA may award additional scholarships if more funding becomes available, as approved by the BCMBA Board of Directors.*

Scholarships are awarded one per recipient and are only valued for post-secondary education. The Scholarship Selection Committee, which includes three (3) BCMBA Board Members, will consider all complete applications received by the deadline. The Scholarship Selection Committee will not enter into correspondence with any applicant's parents, guardians, friends, coaches, etc.

All decisions are final.

Requirements for Eligibility

- 1. The applicant must have completed Grade 12 and be proceeding to an accredited university, college, or other post-secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- 2. The applicant must have demonstrated good citizenship, character, and leadership in a non-playing capacity for their association.
- 3. The applicant must have a minimum average of 68% in their Grade 12 year.
- 4. The applicant must have demonstrated a balance in their academic achievement with a significant demonstration of excellence in character and participation in school activities.
- 5. The applicant must have actively played baseball or umpired within the last 3 years.
- 6. The applicant must be a registered 18UAA/AAA/College Prep player as of their graduating year with an association affiliated with BCMBA.
